1. b. List of schemes submitted by PWD Department

PWD Roads Department has submitted 536 proposals till 27th November 2015 amounting to Rs. 14730.780 Lakh.

Resolution: SEC directed Revenue & DM (General) Department to examine the proposals as per SDRF norms. SEC further directed PWD(Roads) Department to submit prioritize list of proposals out of these proposals in respect of the washed away portion of roads during 2015 floods only.

Agenda Item: 2. Contractual Employees of ASDMA to be covered under EPF Scheme

Resolution: SEC approved the proposal for covering the Contractual Employees of ASDMA under EPF Scheme as informed by the Regional PF Commissioner, Guwahati and directed ASDMA to obtain concurrence of the Finance Department. SEC also approved the proposal of ASDMA for registering PAN card for the purpose of providing EPF to the Contractual Employees of ASDMA.

Helpline number covering 3 (Three) Departments-Police, Medical and Fire Services

approval of the Cabinet.

3. ASDMA will launch IEC activities for popularisation of the 108 integrated helpline

numbers.

4. Home Department and Health Department will also help in popularizing 108 and

take a decision at an appropriate time regarding phasing out other emergency

helpline numbers.

Agenda Item No. 4: Enhancing the existing communication set up at the SEOC and

the DEOCs to strengthen the DM communication network in the SEOC and DEOCs.

SEC directed ASDMA to constitute a Technical Committee with members from

APRO, BSNL and other mobile service providers to develop a proposal for

strengthening the DM Communication network in the State.
