

**Minutes of the meeting of State Executive Committee held on 23rd
September 2016 for examination of SDRF proposals.**

List of the officers present in the meeting is annexed at 'A'.

The meeting was chaired by the Chief Secretary, Assam & Chairman State Executive Committee (SEC).

1. The Chief Executive Officer, Assam State Disaster Management Authority (ASDMA) briefed the Chairperson about the admissible proposals of the Water Resources department under SDRF norms. After detailed discussion the committee approved 11 proposals amounting to Rs.29.06 Crore. The proposals are listed below.

2. Chairman, SEC informed the Committee that Hon'ble Minister, Water Resources had conveyed to him that proposals worth more than Rs.500 Crore are ready with WR department and will be submitted to ASDMA shortly. Chief Secretary and chairman SEC directed that ASDMA to examine the proposals and place it before the committee in the next meeting of SEC to be held on 1st October 2016.
3. Chief Secretary & Chairman, SEC also directed other departments to send their SDRF proposals to ASDMA before the next meeting which will be held on 1st October 2016.
4. Further, Principal Secretary, Revenue & Disaster Management department had sent a text message to the Chief Secretary & Chairman, SEC comprising the following four points:
 - a) Progress of Knowledge Management System is painfully slow. It can be a great tool for continuous capacity-building.
 - b) Project on Village land use Maps in collaboration with NESAC has been dumped. CM is giving a lot of importance to it.
 - c) Fund for formation and training of WDMCs and training of VLMCCs on Village Master Plan and Village Land Use Plan was released long back, but because of confusing signals from ASDMA work has come to a halt.
 - d) Progress of taking co-ordinates of VGRs for GIS mapping has been neglected.

Chairman SEC directed ASDMA to make a detailed note on these four points and place it in the next meeting for discussion.

The meeting ended with thanks from the chair.
